Rebecca's* Story

I shall never forget that January day when I came to the Crisis Pregnancy Center for a pregnancy test. I had a lot of pressure on me to abort if I was pregnant. I already had a 14 month old little girl and very little support from my family. I was afraid and figured that I had to choose abortion. Even after my counselor talked to me, it still seemed that I had no other option.

They told me I could get a free ultrasound exam and that would really show if I was pregnant. So the next day I went to get the exam. There I saw my 14 week old unborn son. He was sucking his fingers, and my heart was touched. When I saw that picture, I felt close to him and knew that I could not have an abortion.

Even though I dropped out of school several years ago, they are helping me to get back in school. As a bonus, I am really enjoying attending the LEAP and Bible study classes at the Center.
