Clients often discover hope in Christ through the sharing of the gospel, find courage to choose life for their unborn by seeing an ultrasound, learn life skills by attending the LEAP (Life Education Assistance Program), and have a sense of being special by having baby items prepared uniquely for them.

In turn, our clients often are the encouragement we need to persevere. Brittany is one of many who have impressed all of us with her determination to succeed in spite of many obstacles. She came to us at the age of sixteen, pregnant, and for the most part on her own. Family members offered little or no help for several months. Brittany was resolute to finish school and found a place to stay with the family of a friend; however, she was totally responsible for all other necessities. She once showed us a well organized notebook of her schoolwork, Medicaid, doctor visits and other essential documents. Every Tuesday night, she walked approximately a mile to and from a bus stop in order to attend the LEAP classes. We had concerns for her safety, but nothing deterred her. Her son, Jordan, was born in March, and she presented him at the Center's baby dedication ceremony in May. His big smile every time he looks at his mother is evidence she is a great loving mom.
