

Help New Believer Mature

Set aside time each day to read and meditate on God's Word.

The Bible is the inspired Word of God (2 Timothy 3:16).

The Bible is the absolute, unchanging truth (Psalm 33:4, John 1:1; 14:6; 17:17, 1 Peter 1:25).

The Bible is our daily nourishment and strength (Matthew 4:4, 2 Peter 1:3-4).

The Bible is both our shield and weapon against evil (Psalm 18:30; 119:14, Ephesians 6:17).

Pray daily with the Lord; do not merely recite words, but carry on a conversation.

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, Your kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one (Matthew 6:9-13).

Fellowship with other believers.

Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good. Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. Honor one another above yourselves. Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, and faithful in prayer. Share with God's people who are in need. Practice hospitality (Romans 12:9-13).

Attend a Bible teaching church.

Let us not give up meeting cooperatively (Hebrews 10:25).

Share communion together (1 Corinthians 11:23-26, Acts 2:42).

Hear the Word explained by God appointed teachers that it might train you in righteousness (2 Timothy 3:16, Luke 24:30-32, 1 Corinthians 12:28).

Encourage and pray one for another (James 5:16, 1 Thessalonians 5:11).

Go and tell others about Jesus.

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age (Matthew 28:19-20).

As you go, preach this message: "The kingdom of heaven is near." Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those who have leprosy, drive out demons. Freely you have received, freely give (Matthew 10:5).
