It is awesome to witness how God transforms individuals and entire families. Dominque came for three years with his daughters, even when his girlfriend, Jennifer, was working and unable to attend. He was intrigued by the study of the Word and rarely missed a class. After three years, Dominque dedicated his life to Jesus, not only as his Savior but also Lord. Jennifer accepted his marriage proposal, they were baptized at a local church, and married at the foot of a church's giant cross.

However, this is not the end of their story but instead a new beginning. The family was gracious to tell their story on a video for our 2017 banquet. At the end of the event, Pastor Rizer from South Belt Church approached Dominque about a part-time position as their Youth Pastor. Since he works full-time at the Post Office, this was a perfect way to start his work in ministry. Raising up a youth pastor goes far beyond the mission statement of our Crisis Pregnancy Center, but what better way to train up the next generation? Dominque is now in a position to speak out with firsthand knowledge supporting a committed relationship with Jesus, spouse and children.

### God is Faithful to Provide Staff

Statistics at our Center each year prove that up to 91 % of women at risk to abort choose life when they view their unborn in the womb. This would never be possible without God providing state of the art ultrasound machines and trained, dedicated RNs and RDMSs. With both, over 5,000 women at-risk to abort have chosen life.

In filing a grant with Focus on the Family in 2005, we discovered the stipulation that an RN serve as Nurse Manager. It so happened Bette Robertson, one of our first volunteers, was a retired nurse. She agreed to return to school, renew her license and accept the responsibility. It was obvious that God foreknew exactly who we needed.

This year before any of us, including Bette, knew that family demands would dictate the need for her to cut weekly hours. God was making preparation by sending RN/RDMS Beth Milner a year earlier to volunteer. She immediately agreed to come on staff and supplement Bette's hours as Assistant Nurse Manager.

One critical component of our success is having a sonographer on duty every hour we are seeing clients. With Bette, Beth and the continued services by RDMSs Kathy Marquardt and Kim Salter many more lives will be saved.
