Good News

We have come to believe that Texas is one of the safest places in America for the preborn and their mothers. Since many of us joined in Austin in the spring of 2013 for the passing of HB2, we have witnessed awesome results from this great new abortion law. We have read of numerous Planned Parenthoods, major abortion providers, and other clinics closing because they cannot comply with the women's safety regulations of the bill. In addition, the restriction of abortions over 20 weeks, coupled with the prior ultrasound bill, have already saved many lives.

Some ask, "How does this impact the clientele at Crisis Pregnancy Centers?" Our answer is simple. It gives us more opportunity to minister to those who find themselves in unwanted pregnancies and to be there as advocates for their unborn children. Their crisis has not changed, and we certainly do not want them to cross state lines to seek abortions.

Deceptive News

We would like for everyone to be aware and well informed that Crisis Pregnancy Centers are under attack by pro-choice organizations. Even though we live in a day of mass communication, news like the following is not always heard:

Direct from **NARAL** Pro-Choice America's website, "We've got Google to take down deceptive ads from anti-choice crisis pregnancy centers, and Yahoo quickly agreed to follow suit."

The American Center for Law & Justice recently sent the following alert. "This is hard to believe, but it's true: The **Center for Reproductive Rights**, a powerful and radical international abortion group, is trying to use the United Nations to stop the pro-life movement. They're actually trying to force the U.N. to use anti-torture treaties to silence the Church, arguing that the pro-life message tortures women. They argue that not even religious freedom should protect the pro-life message and that pro-life leaders should be viewed as international criminals."

Please continue to pray for all the women who find themselves in Crisis Pregnancy Centers and need honest answers. These are direct attacks against Crisis Pregnancy Centers even though we have been extremely careful to advertise with honesty and integrity. Pro-Choice organizations such as these are actually Pro-Abortion, and believe women should not be educated to make any other choice. The good news is Crisis Pregnancy Centers with our free services are impacting the profit of abortionists, because many more women are choosing life for their unborn.
