Like the majority of the Country, we shut our doors on March 16th in an effort to stop the rapid spread of the Coronavirus. Since many of our clients were already struggling financially, we knew the drastic closing of businesses would impact their livelihood. As we called to check on them our primary question was how can we help? Their main response was the need for diapers and wipes. The Blessing Room stock was extremely low, but God immediately brought to mind a drive by diaper drive. One email and our faithful donors responded. It was an incredible site to see car after car drive through, pop their trunks and deliver diapers and wipes. Even with the masks, we could see everyone's smile and hear the excitement of sharing in their voice. As the clients did a drive pickup, we thanked God and all our wonderful supporters for providing.



Reopening Phase I – Seeing Pregnancy-Test Clients

From the beginning of shutdown, God led us to pray Psalm 91. Through His Word He provided confident assurance of His presence, protection and provision during this pandemic and for our reopening. Our daily prayer:

"You Lord are our refuge and our fortress, God, in whom we trust. We stand on your promises and faithfulness to keep all of us who love you, safe from the pestilence and plaque of the Coronavirus. Anoint our lips that others will receive your salvation and shelter during this troubling time. May we give you and you alone all the glory, honor and praise for your protection in this crisis."

As soon as the abortion clinics reopened, we felt compelled to reopen for pregnancy-test clients first as Phase I. With great team work, we were able to develop a very detailed plan for a phased timed reopening. Our number one focus has been, and will remain, safety for all. There are pre-check questions, a temperature check, and oxygen saturation testing upon arrival. We have also adhered to social distancing, masks, hand sanitizer and gloves as appropriate. A large percentage of the clients thus far have been abortion-determined. A few have chosen life, and a couple have prayed to receive Jesus as their Lord and Savior. It has been an incredible blessing to once again be in the arena of God's presence and watch Him save lives. May you also be blessed knowing lives are being saved through this ministry that you pray for and support!

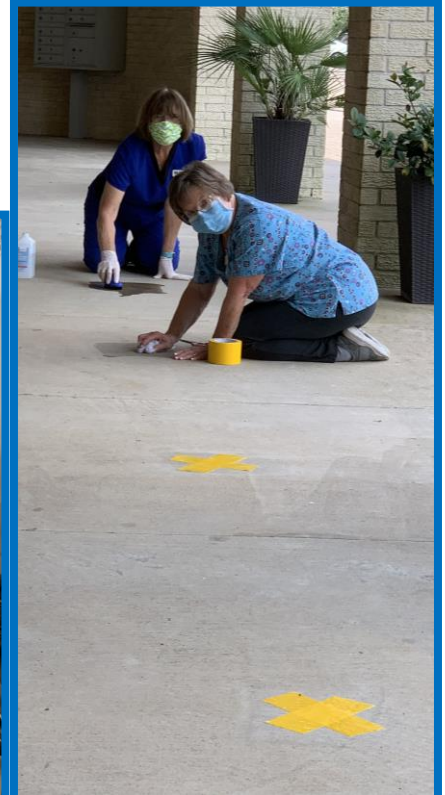
Reopening Phase II – LEAP and Bible Study Classes
